Put your natural Christmas tree out on the curb on any regular green compost cart collection day beginning Tuesday, January 2, 2024.

> Remove all ornaments, decorations, and tinsel.

- Remove stands.
- Trees over 5 ft in height must be cut in half for ease of handling.
- Plastic or flocked trees cannot be recycled. They go in trash. Call our office to schedule pickup between 1/2 & 1/19. After 1/19, a special pick-up is required and may result in

TIPPING YOUR COLLECTOR


If you would like to tip your collectors, please do not leave a gift out where it can be the target of thieves. If you feel comfortable, you may hand your gift directly to them.

It's, Cesar, I'm a driver/collector here at MVRS, and I've got three important reminders to share to help keep everyone safe and our operations smooth.



PLEASE DON'T OVERLOAD **YOUR CARTS**

Each of your carts has a weight limit of 60 pounds, and when they get too heavy, they can break. Plus, it's risky for us collectors to lift. We've seen it happen quite a bit, especially with green carts crammed full of compressed yard waste. If you're using brute force to stuff yard waste in there, it's a sign you've gone overboard! Let's keep it safe and manageable.

BREAK IT DOWN TO MAKE MORE SPACE

Over the holidays we collect a lot of cardboard boxes for recycling. Get in the habbit of flattening those boxes. You'll be amazed at the extra room it creates in your recycling cart. If the cardboard still won't fit, bundle it up in a package no larger than 4'x4'x4', and secure it with some twine or string. Place those bundles right next to your cart on pickup day, and we'll take care of the rest.

TAKE ADVANTAGE OF A FREE CURBSIDE CLEANUP

Did you know that you're entitled to at least two free curbside cleanups each year? If you schedule it in advance of your pickup day, we'll swing by and collect up to three cubic yards from your home. This is great for spring cleaning or just properly disposing of that extra waste that you've been holding on to. CALIFORNIA'S MANDATORY ORGANICS RECYCLING LAW

California law, **SB 1383**, passed in 2022, aims to keep food and other compostable materials out of landfills by requiring all generators of waste (businesses, public entities, and single/multifamily residents) to properly sort their waste, by either placing organics in the compost cart or self-hauling to a composting facility or program. Residents must also place recyclables (paper, cardboard, cans, and bottles) in the recycling cart.



We've made this easy for you! Compost, Recycling, and Garbage Service are all part of your normal service package, and has been for years, with Mill Valley Refuse. All you need to do is sort your organic waste correctly including food, food soiled

paper, and plant debris into your green compost cart, and paper, cardboard, cans, and bottles into your recycling cart(s).
